Targets forum delayed

KEY POINTS:

Our targets forum is delayed

The targets forum with the bank that was due to be held today (Friday 2 October) has been delayed.

Westpac has told us that due to various internal changes there would not be anyone present who is involved in the decision making process around targets if it was to proceed this Friday.

We have told the bank we would prefer to wait until they can front with real decision makers. The forum is therefore re-scheduled to occur in just over a month in mid-November.
